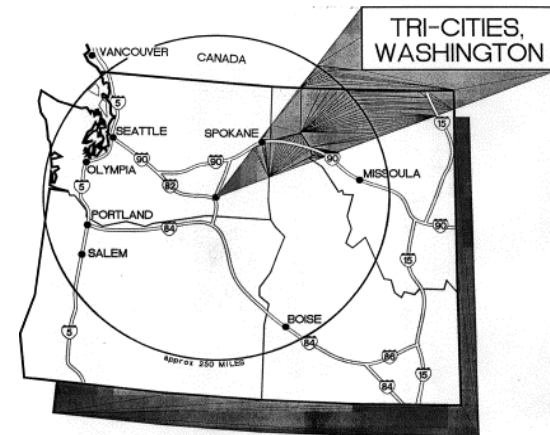
## City Information:
